Sunday School

- **Meet on Wednesday evenings to provide special, elementary music teaching to preschoolers through simple songs, rhythm instruments, and hand bells.**

Vacation Bible School

- Gives preschoolers and children a week-long adventure during the summer to learn more about God and his world through Bible studies, crafts, music, missions, recreation, and snacks.

Winter Retreat

- Enables 3rd-5th grade students to break away from their daily routines to spend a weekend with God and their friends, learning together through Bible study, meaningful games, special crafts, and a whole lot of fun!
